




Q.1 How do you rate Programme in terms of the curriculum syllabi in different semesters?




Q2. How do you rate the availability of the text and reference books in the library?




Q3. How do you rate the quality and relevance of the courses included in the curriculum?




Q4. How do you rate the ambiance of the classroom's effective delivery of the lectures?







Q6. How do you rate courses in terms of their relevance to the latest and/ or future technologies?




Q7. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?




Q8. How do you rate programs based on the assignment and quizzes conducted?




Q9. How do you rate the quality of the teaching in the Institution?




Q10. How do you rate the transparency of the evaluation system in the University?




Q11. How do you rate University activities that help in getting jobs and placements?




Q12 How do you rate the quality of teaching during the entire Programme?




Q13 How do you rate the teacher's approach to your overall development?




Q14 How do you rate the fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers?
