It was further suggested that credits allotted for dissertation in the sixth trimester be reduced by two and the same be adjusted in the dissertation of fifth trimester.

11AC (D-3-2) BHM 3 year's Programme from 2015 -16

The proposal was withdrawn.

11AC (D-3-3) Proposal to Change the Nomenclature of the Hotel Management Programme from BHMCT to BHM for Batch 2014-18 (Retrospective)

The proposal was dropped by the Council.

11AC (D-3-4) Proposal to Reduce the Credit of BHM Batch 2014-18 and BHM Batch 2013-17 from 200 to 190

The proposal was dropped by the Council.



12AC (D-1-5) Introduction of National Service Scheme (NSS) as an Elective Subject in Higher Education:

In compliance of MHRD direction, the Council approved the proposal to offer 'Introduction of National Service Scheme (NSS)' as open elective subject from the Academic Year 2015-16. It was suggested that Faculty of Arts & Law should own the course and wherever required, the expertise from other schools may be incorporated for this course.

12AC (D-2) FACULTY OF ENGINEERING

12AC (D-2-1) Revamping of Scheme and Syllabi of B Tech II Year:

The Council approved the revamped scheme & syllabi of B Tech second year with following suggestions:

1. History to be rephrased as 'History of Science & Technology.'
2. The content of History of Science & Technology to be revised and around 50-60% of the content should be a generic prospective of history and remaining portion to be branch specific.
3. Year of edition to be mentioned for suggested Reference Books for Economics course

✓ **12AC (D-2-2) Introduction of Programme Elective for Department of Mechanical Engineering:**

The proposal to offer "Introduction to Micro Electro Mechanical Systems" as Programme Elective was approved by the Council.

12AC (D-2-3) Scheme & Syllabi M.Tech (PES) by Research:

Scheme & syllabi of M.Tech (PES) by Research was not approved by the Council in its submitted format. It was advised that scheme and syllabi be revisited and reframed under supervision of Director SEEC and Dean FoE and finally be submitted to the Chairperson Academic Council for consideration.



15AC (D-2-2) Scheme and Syllabi of M Tech (VLSI Design & Technology):

The proposed scheme and syllabi of M Tech (VLSI & Technology) was approved by the Council. The programme will be offered by Department of Electronics & Communication Engineering.

15AC (D-2-3) Scheme and Syllabi of B Tech (Automobile Engineering):

The proposed scheme and syllabi of B Tech (Automobile Engineering) was approved by the Council. It will be effective for batches 2015-19, 2014-18, 2013-17.

The Council suggested that during revising the scheme / syllabi of any programme, the concerned department should consult other contributory departments for their inputs.

✓ **15AC (D-2-4) Change in Scheme and Nomenclature of Courses of B Tech (Mechanical Engineering):**

The Council approved the proposed changes in the scheme and nomenclature of courses offered by Department of Mechanical Engineering.

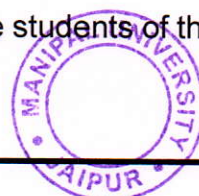
The Council also advised that course codes be changed with change in nomenclature of the course. This will be effective from academic session 2016-17.

15AC (D-2-5) Revision in Syllabi of B Tech Mechatronics Engineering Programme:

The Council approved the revision in syllabi of the courses, Modern Control System (MC 1752) and Mechatronics System Design (MC 1702). The Council further approved the changes in syllabi of Digital System Design (MC 1406) being offered in B Tech (Mechatronics Engineering) programme. Revised syllabi will be applicable for the batches 2013-17 and 2014-18.

15AC (D-2-6) Collaborative M Tech with C-DAC:

In order to encourage the industry connect programme, the Council advised that running of collaborative M Tech with C-DAC should be publicized adequately. The Council approved the duration of tenure of members of the Faculty Boards for a period of 03 (Three) years like statutory bodies and recommended that the matter be placed before the Board of Management for consideration and approval.

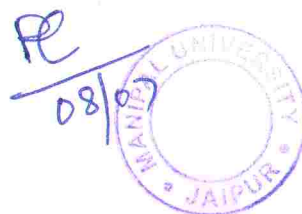




