



Agenda 5: Increase batch intake from 30 to 60 seats in 2015 and to 90 seats thereafter.

As proposed by the Chairman BoS, the members recommended the increase of seat limit.

Other discussion topic:

- SHM tie up with MIS: All the members agreed that the tie up of SHM with MIS would be beneficial for the BHM students and for the department. The tie up would equip the department in providing better training opportunities to the students.
- Academic tie up with WGSHA: All the of MUJ representatives members agreed that the WGSHA is pioneered in hospitality education in India, tie up with WGSHA would be highly beneficial to SHM, MUJ. Prof. Parvadhavardhini Gopalakrishnan, Principal WGSHA whole heartedly agreed to extend the support towards faculty exchange, sharing academic resources & skill development trainings of faculty members of MUJ.
