





19AC (D) DISCUSSION & DECISION ITEMS

19AC (D-1) UNIVERSITY AGENDA

19AC (D-1-1) Introduction of New Programme:

In-principle approval was accorded by the Council to introduce M Sc (Environmental Science) from Academic Year 2018-19 with an intake of 20.

19AC (D-1-2) Late Fee for Academic Registration:

In order to discourage students for late academic registration, the proposal pertaining to impose a late fee of Rs 5000/- for registration after the declared last date for the registration / re-registration, was approved by the Council. This will be applicable from Academic Year 2017-18.

The late fee will be imposed only once (for a particular semester), irrespective of registration / re-registration of different courses.

19AC (D-1-3) Accreditation of the University:

Considering the importance of accreditation and compliance of the statutory provision, the Council opined that the University should submit the application for NAAC Accreditation by December 2017.

The Pro-President was requested to take the lead in this regard and convene a review meeting in mid - September 2017.

19AC (D-1-4) Implementation of Environmental Studies as Compulsory Course in UG Programmes:

The Council advised to comply with the suggestions of UGC. A course on Environmental Studies (ES1101), taught in B Tech 1st Year, is in line with the suggested module of UGC.

All concerned were requested to incorporate this course in the scheme and syllabi of all the Programmes of their respective faculty, from next semester onwards.

19AC (D-1-5) Online Platform for Teaching Learning Process:

The Council suggested to implement MOOCs in academic cycle as per the following guidelines:
