01	Introduction of more industry relevant courses	Industry related courses like Data Analytics, AI and Soft Computing were included. Revised curriculum was deliberated upon in 24 th Meeting of the Academic Council and approved. New curriculum will be effective from Admission 2019 onwards.
02	Giving weightage on MOOCs	Due weightage has been given to MOOCs. As per new curriculum, students may opt MOOCs as open elective courses.
03	Reduction of overall credits to complete the programme	Considering regulatory compliance, overall credit has been reduced to complete the respective programme
04	Giving more emphasize on hands on training	Project based learning was introduced in new revamped curriculum
05	Increase the lab component	Due weightage was given to practical courses
06	Allowing to complete Open elective as optional course	Open elective course will be offered as Mandatory Learning Course as per new curriculum. The credit of Open Elective Course will not be counted in calculation of credit requirement for completion of any programme.
07	Emphasizing Contemporary Courses	Many more courses relevant to modern day teaching learning have been added.
