

## 16 AC (C-12) Academic Collaborations:

To foster academic and research excellence, the recent initiatives taken by the University in terms of Academic Collaborations with CSIR-IIP Dehradun and Institute of Public Enterprise, Hyderabad, were noted by the Council.

### 16AC (C-13) Faculty Status:

The Council noted the faculty status as on Sep. 15, 2016. In addition, available Faculty members as Emeritus / Visiting / Adjunct Professors and Teaching Assistants were also noted.

## 16AC (C-14) Creation of the Departments:

Creation of two departments, namely Department of Design and Department of Planning under School of Planning & Design were noted by the Council.

The Council also noted the programmes offered under these departments.

#### 16AC (C-15) Admissions 2016:

The Council was apprised of the admissions for the academic session 2016-17. It was also reported that another 30-40 students are expected to join the Executive MBA Programme in November, 2016.
