



A. AGENDA FOR DISCUSSION

26AC (A-1): 6th Convocation

The University is organizing its 6th Convocation on November 8-10, 2019

1. Award of Degrees to the Graduate Students

The Council considered 1778 students including 27 Ph D scholars, who have fulfilled all requirements for the award of Degrees in AY 2018-19 and approved their names for award of degree during the 6th Convocation to be held on November 08-10, 2019. It was recommended that the same be placed before the Board of Management in its next meeting for consideration and approval.

The Council noted and approved the same.



2. Chairperson's Gold Medal Award for Overall Excellence

As per the recommendation of the committee constituted for scrutinizing and nominating students, the Council approved the award of Chairperson's Gold Medal Award for overall excellence to Ms Varsha Priyadarshini from Department of ECE for the year 2019. The council recommended that the matter be placed before the Board of Management in its next meeting for consideration and further approval.

26AC (B-5) Controller of Examination

- The council deferred the proposal to change the degree nomenclature of MBA programme and suggested that the Controller of Examination to submit a proposal to the Chairman of Academic Council with more clarity. After due deliberations on the agenda it was suggested to issue the degree in single specialization only.
- Nomenclature for BA LLB (Hons) to be revised as per the UGC degree nomenclature to BA LLB (Hons) Five Year Integrated Programme.

- b) Best academic processes be followed and references can be obtained from other Universities. The various policies adoped by the University to improve the quality of Ph D Programme was lauded by the Committee.

26AC (B-7) Directorate of Academics

Academic Rules for old batch students in the upcoming Academic Council Meeting (i.e. Students Admitted prior to 2019 Batch)

As per our existing Academic regulation, Make-up Examination is conducted for the students having F or I Grade.

- a) Students are allowed to appear in each end term examination including registered /re-registered as well as non-registered students (i.e. Students directly appearing for end term examination in the form of Make-up Examination).
- b) From this semester onwards (July —Nov 2019) (As per our New Academic Regulations and Academic calendar as well) we are going to conduct a Make-Up examination separately just after the declaration of the End Term examination results (i.e. January 2020 and June 2020).

With respect to the above agenda, a proposal is as (only for Academic session 2019-2020):

a) During the End term examination ONLY registered / Re-Registered student should be allowed to appear in the scheduled examination. The rest of the students (i.e. non-registered students having FR grade) may be allowed to appear only in the Make-Up Examination (i.e. for Odd Semester January 2020 and for Even Semester June 2020).

The Council noted and ratified the same. Director Academics was suggested to communicate the matter appropriately to the concerned.
