A very productive and motivating day and meeting together during your visit to the Ecole Bleue Paris, yesterday.

I trust you gained all the necessary information about the school and dont hesitate to contact me if you have any further questions. We appreciated your presentation of Manipal and your responses to Jean-Baptiste's questions concerning the upcoming exchange.

I have sent a debriefing following the topics we discussed to my colleagues and we will get back to you soon on possible developments and projects that can enlarge the opportunities and scope of our partnership and sharing.

Amongst our proposals:

- Student exchanges for one semester. Ecole Bleue Semester 1 October - February, Semester 2 January - June.
- Ecole Bleue students exchanging to Manipal from 1 August to end December.
- Exchange workshops of a duration of +/- one week. Sufficient time to run a complete project from briefing to completion and evaluation.
- Seminars of a couple of days and conferences by visiting professors.
- Joint projects by classes working in Paris & Jaipur simultaneously with connection and sharing via Skype, FaceTime and shared digital files, evaluations.
- Participation as jury members in each others school graduation juries.

- Professor exchanges for a duration to be determined.
- Sharing knowledge and best practices.

We await your input and suggestions to compliment these ideas.

As far as your possible exchange students joining us in Paris is concerned.

- Exchange semester dates are as mentioned above.
- Students will integrate the Y3 class, this including the Foundation year is the equivalent of 4th Year.
- As agreed we will waiver all language examination requirements, we would just ask your confirmation of a 'good' to 'excellent' level of English comprehension and language. The students will also have the opportunity to learn or develop French during their visit.

- Typical living, food, travel, mobile phone cost per month start at minimum €300+. A shared studio will be the most economic option for your students, this is what our other exchange students from Asia have done.

Attached are some samples of typical curriculum classes and subjects studied in Y3.

A reminder, this is the **Global Design** program, so students will take classes in the three principal fields of: Interior Design, Graphic Design, Product Design, as well as complimentary classes in drawing, perspective, colour, lighting & materials, culture, software etc.

We await reception of your students application files as soon as possible. In the next couple of weeks will be ideal. Places are limited!

Upon reception and review we will issue the official invitation lettres signed by the school director.

Indispensable for application for a student study visa.

Likewise we await the invitation lettre for Mr Jean-Baptiste Persichini, so he can initiate his student visa process.

You will be receiving his application, sent again, via We Transfer this weekend.

Again, a very fruitful and positive meeting and we look forward to developing our partnership and future projects.
