Central Registry of Securitisation Asset Reconstruction & Security Interest

- Introduction to CERSAI
- Sections 26B of the SARFEASI Act (inserted by way of Section 18 of the Amendment Act) extends the provision of registration requirements under the SARFEASI Act to any security interest over any property.
- **What is the impact of filing or non-filing of Security Interest?**
- (a) Doctrine of constructive notice for charge registered prior in time: Section 26C(1) of SARFEASI Act (inserted by way of Section 18 of the Amendment Act) stipulates that registration of interests, including attachment orders, will serve as a public notification, so that anyone dealing with the property cannot claim to be ignorant about the existence of such interests.
- Further, Section 26C(2) provides priority to registered charges, i.e. where there is a registered security interest, any subsequent security interest on the property will be subordinated to a pre-registered interest. While the priorities are a matter of contract and the general rule is that priorities should be as per the contract, but Section 26C(2) provides that the unregistered creditor will not be able to claim the priority available to a registered security interest.
