Professor AD Vyas Sir and Professor Lalita Ledwani Ma'am delivered the welcome address.

Dr. Shivi Saxena then shed light on the significance of goal setting and provided a clear understanding of its importance and impact. She began with a lot of real-life examples that were relatable for the students and kept the crowd engaged. She made the students perform an activity on goal setting and even spoke about SMART goals. She spoke about the significance of prioritizing tasks as well as time management.

After the break, there was a second session by Dr. Richa Mishra. She talked about self-management and the importance of critical thinking.

Critical thinking is a kind of thinking in which you question, analyse, interpret, evaluate and make a judgment about what you read, hear, say, or write. She also shed light on the key critical thinking skills that are analysis, interpretation, inference, explanation, self-regulation, open-mindedness, and problem-solving.

This workshop was insightful for the students. Along with a great session, students were given e-certificates.

4. Brief Description of the event

Two sessions were held in this event by the speaker Psy. Nisha Jain Grover (counselling psychologist) and Dr. Vandana Kanth (behavioral scientist). The event aimed to make students aware of mental well-being through topics of growth mindset and self-management.

The session commenced with the inauguration of by Prof. Vijay Laxmi Sharma, Department of Law and Prof. Anil Dutt Vyas, Directorate of Student's Welfare. First session was conducted by Psy. Nisha Jain Grover on the topic of Mental Well-Being: Transforming Minds on Growth Mindset. She briefed about mental well-being that it can be described as a combination of how we feel (our emotions and life satisfaction) and how we function (relationships with others, personal control, purpose in life, and independence). It is something that affects everyone, old and young, and anyone can experience good or poor mental well-being.

Finding a hobby (such as gardening, playing sports, cooking, or arts and craft) giving to others by volunteering, being there for a friend in need, or caring for animals, having someone to talk to who can provide support and reassurance, eating healthily and exercising regularly. She also gave different tips that students can follow for good well-being.

- 1. Connect with other people- good relationships are important for your mental well-being.
- Be physically active -Being active is not only great for your physical health and fitness.Evidence also shows it can also improve your mental wellbeing.
- Pay attention to the present moment (mindfulness)

Paying more attention to the present moment can improve your mental wellbeing.

After the break, there was a second session by Dr. Vandana Kanth (behavioral scientist). She talked about Self-Management and how self-management is important. Self-management, which is also referred to as "self-control" or "self-regulation," is the ability to regulate one's emotions, thoughts, and behaviors effectively in different situations.

Self-management is our ability to regulate emotions and control actions and behaviors. It's why we don't miss work deadlines or overreact to workplace conflicts. With remote work and hybrid working, self-management in business has become more important than ever.



The session commenced with the inauguration of by Prof. Vijay Laxmi Sharma, Department of Law and Prof. Anil Dutt Vyas, Directorate of Student's Welfare. First session was conducted by Psy. Nisha Jain Grover on the topic of Mental Well-Being: Transforming Minds on Growth Mindset. - Be physically active -Being active is not only great for your physical health and fitness.Evidence also shows it can also improve your mental wellbeing.
- Pay attention to the present moment (mindfulness)

Paying more attention to the present moment can improve your mental wellbeing.

After the break, there was a second session by Dr. Vandana Kanth (behavioral scientist). She talked about Self-Management and how self-management is important. Self-management, which is also referred to as "self-control" or "self-regulation," is the ability to regulate one's emotions, thoughts, and behaviors effectively in different situations.

Self-management is our ability to regulate emotions and control actions and behaviors. It's why we don't miss work deadlines or overreact to workplace conflicts. With remote work and hybrid working, self-management in business has become more important than ever.


