#### **Objective of Course/Project:**



#### **Syllabus:**

Learners will practice giving personal information, asking questions, making polite requests, and expressing preferences. The course also includes topics such as talking about one's city, profession, family, interests, daily routines, and making appointments. Students will learn to understand and convey simple information, make reservations, write a postcard, express impressions, discuss weather, festivals, and engage in basic telephone conversations using common vocabulary and expressions.
