In the context of marginalized categories, it addresses the fundamental ideas surrounding the production of identities, social spaces, gender, and diverse sexualities. This course's main focus is on how society and the law interact in a patriarchal, heteronormative social structure. It investigates how laws are made and how they are incorporated into societal-legal structures. It challenges the queer articulations of law to honor and acknowledge them.
