

## **PhD Admissions: January 2026**

### **Important Guidelines for Candidates**

#### **1. Program Duration**

1.1. Full Time – Minimum 3 Y – Max 6 Y

1.2. Part Time – Minimum 4 Y – Max 6 Y

**2.** Every successful candidate must register for Course Work in the First Year of the program.

**3. Residential Requirement of one semester with Min 75% attendance in MUJ campus is necessary – for both Full-Time and Part – Time candidates.**

**4.** Application Fee: Rs. 1200/- (Non-refundable)

#### **5. Program Fee:**

5.1. Registration Fee: Rs. 10,000/- (One Time – Non-Refundable)

5.2. Tuition Fee: Rs. 30,000/- (Till the final submission of Thesis)

#### **6. Eligibility Criteria for PhD Entrance Examination**

##### ***6.1. PhD Scholars having PG degree in a discipline***

(a) Candidates who have qualified Post Graduate degree or any equivalent professional degree from a recognized academic institution (with not less than 55% of marks, or a CGPA of 5.5 and above in the 10-point scale) are eligible for admission in PhD programme at MUJ.

(b) Candidates having minimum 50% marks in the qualifying examination of CA /ICWA will be eligible for admission in PhD programme at MUJ. However, such eligible candidates will have to go through the regular selection process of MUJ.

##### ***6.2. PhD Scholars having UG degree in a discipline***

(a) The candidates having 4 years / 8 semester undergraduate (bachelor's) degree may be allowed to get direct admission in PhD program provided they have a minimum of 75% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade on a point scale wherever the grading system is followed.

(b) A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the UGC from time to time.

(c) Further, candidates with industry experience of 10 or more years in the relevant field along with valid UG degree will be given a relaxation of 10% in the minimum eligibility criteria.

6.3. The candidates who are NET/SLET/JRF/GATE/ M.Phil. qualified or will be exempted from the written test. They have to appear for the interview only.

**7. Candidates applying for Part Time registration will have to submit the NoC from the current employer at the time of interview.**

8. Only 20% of the total seats of a department will be allotted for the part-time registrations.

### 9. Entrance Examination

9.1. The written test would comprise of 100 MCQs.

9.2. The following marking scheme of the examination from the upcoming session:

After written examination only the candidates scoring marks  $\geq 40$  will be called for interview.
