INTER OFFICE NOTE

BAN ON RAGGING

- All students are hereby warned that RAGGING is banned in Manipal University Jaipur. They are once again reminded that they have signed an undertaking stating that they will desist from indulging in RAGGING.
- 2. The Hon'ble Supreme Court has also directed that **RAGGING** be banned from all educational institutions. **RAGGING** has been made a cognizable offence and it attracts a punishment of **Rigorous Imprisonment up to three years and a fine of 25,000/-. RAGGING** has been defined as:-

"Any act causing, inducing, compelling or forcing a student whether by way of a practical joke or otherwise, to do any act which detracts from human dignity or violates his person or exposes him to ridicule or to forbear from doing any unlawful act, by intimidating, wrongfully restraining, wrongfully confining, or injuring him or by using criminal force to him or by holding out to him any threat of such intimidation, wrongful restraint, wrongful confinement, injury or the use of criminal force".

- 3. Also the student accused of ragging:
 - a. Will not be recommended for passport application.
 - b. Will be given Transfer Certificate with endorsement of criminal tendency.
 - c. Will be suspended immediately and expelled from MUJ after completion of enquiry.
 - d. Will be expelled from MUJ immediately if the evidence is proved, without investigation.
- 4. HOD of each Department will ensure that this Inter Office Note No. MUJ/REGR/1403/169 is read out in each class/section/division of his Department once in the first week of every month. A record will be maintained with the signature of the faculty members who has read it.



- 5. HOD of each Department will also ensure that movement of First Year students from class to lab or lab to class or from one class to another is organized under the escort of a responsible Lab Assistant.
- 6 Faculty members taking class in First Year will not leave the class before the faculty member for the next hour arrives.
- 7. Under no circumstances, a student in First Year Class will be allowed to leave the class to go out for any purpose by the faculty member taking the class unless a written permission for the same is given by Director, dean or HOD except in the case of medical emergency. In the case of medical emergency, the First Year student will be permitted to go out under escort of a responsible staff member.
