




DAASTAAN- Convergence

DATE: 04/11/2023-05/11/2023



DATE: 15/09/2023-17/09/2023




Hack {Her} - IEEE WIE Date of the Event: 17/02/2023-18/02/2023


Tech Trends - IEEE WIE Date of the Event: 31/10/2023
