First of all Prof. B. K. Sharma, Convenor, AIRC welcomed all the committee members. In particular, he expressed special thanks to Mr. Tara Chand Tak of Zodiac Pharma for agreeing to set up Research Centre in MUJ. He also informed that HPLC facility has been established as per MoU agreement.

Subsequently, various agenda items of the meeting were discussed.

The decisions of this meeting are as under:

 Training on the use of HPLC be arranged for the teaching staff and students of science faculty of MUJ in I phase during 18th May, 2015 to 31st May, 2015. In I phase only faculty and research scholars from Department of Chemistry and Department of Biosciences, MUJ will be included. Prof. Lalita Ledwani shall coordinate for chemistry faculty and Dr. M. M. Sharma for Biosciences.

• Groups will be made of 7-8 trainees and names will be incorporated in the group on first come first serve basis. There will be a group leader in each group. Students (UG & PG) will also be doing projects on HPLC.

Names will be collected by above mentioned members of AIRC. Further, Dr. S. N.
Sharan, Dr. N. N. Sharma, Dr. Anil Dutt Vyas shall circulate this information in their
departments and coordinate the training of faculty and research scholars in their
respective domains.

 A five day workshop is being organized by Department of Chemistry for B.Sc. pass students from MUJ and outsiders, out of which one day probably 21st May 2015 will be dedicated to HPLC training.

• As for the materials, standards, solvents etc., required for HPLC, they would be procured by MUJ. Prof. Lalita Ledwani will arrange these materials on the need base.

• For training of outsiders, dates and other norms will be finalized in next meeting.

• Two other proposals namely from BOSCH and SIEMENS are in the final stage of approval. These will be discussed later after the decision of the President.
