31AC (A-1): Faculty of Engineering

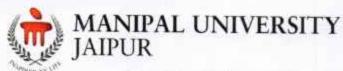

Considering the recommendation of Faculty Board of Faculty of Engineering, the Council approved the syllabus of "B Tech in Electrical and Computer Engineering". This will be effective from academic session 2021-22.

The Council also approved some minor changes in the scheme, as proposed.

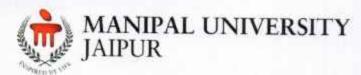
## 31AC (A-2) Directorate of Online Education

31AC (A-2-1) List of New Programmes to be offered under Online Mode, from Academic Session Jan-Feb 2022.

The Council deliberated on the proposal of Directorate of Online Education to offer the following programmes through online mode:

- Bachelor of Commerce (B. Com)
- Master of Commerce (M. Com)
- Master of Arts-Journalism & Mass Communication (MA-J&MC)

It was brought to the notice of the Council that the University preliminary committee had given in principle go ahead to launch these programs.



The Council noted and approved the introduction of the new programmes to be offered through online mode.

## 31AC (A-3): Faculty of Arts & Law

31AC (A-3-1): Approval of proposed course structure of all semesters and syllabus of first year of MA Economics.

Considering the recommendation of Faculty Board of Faculty of Arts & Law, the Council approved the course structure of all semesters and syllabus of first year of "MA Economics" for the students to be admitted from AY 2021-22 and onwards.

## 31AC (A-4): Faculty of Management & Commerce

31AC (A-4-1): Approval of syllabus for different specializations offered under the Online MBA program.

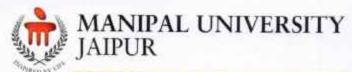

After thorough discussion on the agenda, it was suggested to have an interim discussion on this in the preliminary meeting and if needed, it's approval could be sought from the council through circular resolution.

In accordance with the suggestions in the 30th Academic Council meeting, the syllabi of minor specialization in (i) Machine Learning & Artificial Intelligence, and (ii) Cyber Security, for students of B. Tech in Electronics & Communication Engineering was modified and the same was placed before the council for approval.

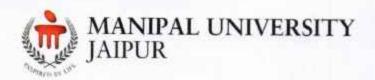

Considering recommendation of Faculty Board of FoE, the Council noted and ratified the above agenda.

## 31AC (B-3-3) Revision in Course Outcomes of some courses in B Tech Automobile Engineering and B Tech Computer Science & Engineering

The proposal to revise course outcomes of some courses in B Tech Automobile Engineering and B Tech Computer Science & Engineering was placed before the council.

31AC (B-3-4) Minor Corrections in Course names and Course codes of B Tech Electronics and Communication Engineering programme and minor revision in syllabus of few courses for B Tech Computer Science Engineering programme.

Considering recommendation of Faculty Board of FoE, the Council noted and ratified the following:

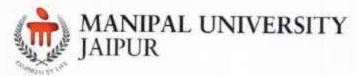

- Revision in course syllabus of CS2203 Computer Organization and CS2202 Relational Database Management Systems for B Tech Computer Science Engineering.

The Council advised that the course codes need to be thoroughly checked by the Directorate of Academics, before being placed in the Academic Council.

Considering recommendation of Faculty Board of FoE, the Council noted and approved the agenda with the suggestion that the assessment of all these MOOC courses should be proctored. As for offering the MOOC courses for PhD scholars, it was suggested that the respective DRCs have the responsibility to ensure that the level of the course should be level 6 or above, before being offered to the scholars.

## 31AC (B-3-6) Closure of M Tech in Electronics & Communication Engineering (ECE) Programme

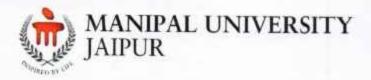
Proposal for Closure of M Tech in Electronics & Communication Engineering (ECE)

Programme was placed before the council for approval.

It was conveyed that due to less demand for admission to conventional degree programmes, the department is inclined towards offering programmes in specialized domains.

The Council noted and approved the above agenda.





## 31AC (B-4) Faculty of Management & Commerce

31AC (B-4-1) Introduction of 3 credits course on R programming in the 2nd year of MBA 2020-22 Batch.

31AC (B-4-2) Provision of Capstone Project in lieu of Summer Internship for students whose internships might be cancelled in the prevailing pandemic.

The proposal to introduce 3 credit course in R programming in 2<sup>nd</sup> year of MBA program and provision to offer capstone project instead of summer internship, owing to the pandemic situation was placed before Council.

Considering recommendation of Faculty Board of FoMC, the Council noted and approved the same.

31AC (B-4-3) Modification/Revision proposed in the curriculum of programmes under SHTM

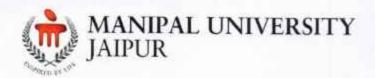
Considering recommendation of Faculty Board of FoMC, the Council noted and approved the following agenda:

- Modification in the BHM curriculum for batch 2018-19
- Revision of BHM scheme and syllabus for batch 2021-25.
- Revision of the scheme and syllabus of BBA (Hospitality and Tourism operations)
   for batch 2021-24.

The agenda to revise Admission Eligibility Criteria of BBA (Hospitality and Tourism operations) was also deliberated in detail. The Council advised that the department should not revise the eligibility criteria for BBA (Hospitality and Tourism operations) in line with the revision proposed for the eligibility criteria for BBA programme being offered through online mode.

Provision of lateral admission to BBA (Hospitality & Tourism operations) program was discussed in detail.

It was suggested that before admitting any student through lateral entry, academic equivalence of the credit earned by the student in his/her previous academic enrolment/programme, need to be thoroughly checked by a committee constituted for



the purpose. It was also suggested that the concerned student and parents should be informed of the recommendation of the committee, prior to admitting the student for the programme. If needed, an undertaking can be taken from them so as to avoid any issue in future.

## 31AC (B-4-4) Interchange in course codes as proposed by Department of Business Administration

Department of Business Administration proposed to interchange the course codes assigned to the courses to be taught in B. Tech IT branch as:

- Finance & Econometrics BB1340
- · Operation Research BB1640

# 31AC (B-5-1) Introduction of few courses and shifting of practical training course for programme under School of Architecture & Design

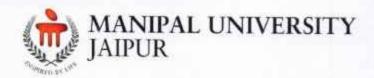

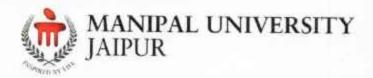
Considering recommendation of Faculty Board of FoAL, the Council noted and approved the following:

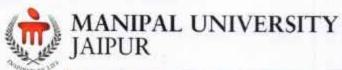
## 31AC (D-1) "Guidelines for Even Semester End-Term/Make-up Examination process, A.Y. 2020-21"

## 31AC (D-2) Academic Load - Direct Contact Hours for Faculty Members at MUJ

In compliance to the UGC guidelines, a proposal to fix direct contact hours (academic load) for faculty members with different designation was placed before the council for approval, which will be effective from next academic cycle, August 2021.

Along with this, the following points were also proposed and deliberated in the Academic Council:

- If the Academic load assigned for any faculty is less than the minimum prescribed, such faculty may be given higher research target by HoD.
- The Academic load of faculty to be calculated from the individual timetable of faculty rather than the data from DMS/AMS / SLcM
- All faculty are recommended to teach at least one UG and one PG theory course or 2 UG theory course per semester.

Chairman suggested to continue with the above arrangement for a year and if there is any change proposed, it could be done only in the next academic year.

Chairman reiterated that for any University system, the academic activities or processes form the backbone. He called upon the Deans and Directors to contribute in their own way for strengthening these processes. He expressed his happiness in the way people outside the University look up to the streamlined academic and research practices being followed in the University.

The meeting ended with a thanking note to all for active participation.
