The Council gave in-principle approval for all the proposed new programmes and also for programmes seeking revised intake in the number of seats, with the following suggestion:

The complete program structure of the new programmes to be offered from the next
Academic Year 23-24 must be deliberated / approved at Board of Studies of the
respective departments and further approved by the respective Faculty Board. This
has to be placed in the next Academic Council meeting.

36AC (A-2): Controller of Examinations

- Proposal to permit the office of CoE to print Month and Year of completion of degree program in the degree certificates from the year 2023, instead of current practice of printing academic year.
- For all delayed students, the date in the degree certificate is the date of completion
 of all the academic formalities irrespective of convocation date printed for
 Cohorts/batch.
- Academic year wise graduates shall be finalized after considering delayed degrees.
- Delayed degrees count shall be concluded, if the student completes all academic formalities for the award of degree, within 3 months after the detailed month of completion for the cohorts/batch.
- Beyond 3 months, it is the discretion of the respective Dean of the Faculty and Chairperson Academic Council to consider any student under delayed graduate with the cohort/batch.

After much deliberation, the Council approved to print Month and Year of completion of degree programme in the degree certificates from the year 2023 which will be beneficial for the students / research scholars across the University.

36AC (A-3): Directorate of Academics

36AC (A-3-1) Status of MOOCs through SWAYAM/NPTEL platform with credit transfer

Director, DoA, proposed the idea of offering MOOCs through SWAYAM/NPTEL platform with credit transfer under different categories.

The Council approved the above agenda with the following suggestions:

- PhD coursework (Research Ethics) can be offered through SWAYAM/NPTEL platform.
- For detained students, the faculty should identify an equivalent course in SWAYAM/NPTEL platform and credits must be transferred on successful completion of the course.



 The bridge courses for the lateral entry/transfer students may be made mandatory to clear via the SWAYAM/NPTEL platform.

36AC (A-4): Department of Journalism and Mass Communication

36AC (A-4-1) Approval of the revised Syllabus and Course structure of MAJMC online program

The Council approved the revised Syllabus and Course structure of MAJMC online program.

36AC (A-5): Faculty of Law

36AC (A-5-1) Approval of 1 credit course: LAW1010 - Constitutional Law to B. Tech 1st Year

Considering the inputs from Dean FoL, the Council approved to offer this course to the 1st year B. Tech students from AY 2023-34 onwards in an online platform as a MOOC course and suggested that the Department of Law should come up with the detailed syllabus, course plan and assessment pattern approved at BoS / Faculty Board of FoL and get ratified in the next Academic Council meeting.

36AC (A-5-2) Approval of Online Course(s) on SWAYAM/NPTEL with credit transfer

The Council suggested to put this agenda on hold as it lacked information and needed more clarity.

36AC (A-6): Faculty of Engineering

36AC (A-6-1) New proposed curriculum structure for all B. Tech. Programme batch 2023-2027 onwards in FoE as per curriculum conclave of Faculty of Engineering held on January 16, 2023

Dean FoE, briefed on the draft framework/schema of all the 17 programmes to be offered by FoE from AY 2023-24 onwards.

The Council suggested the following:

- 1) To look carefully into the assessment schema, especially on the Internal Assessment component (70%) / ETE component (30%), whether we do have reached that stage or else are we conducting our examinations & evaluation in a robust manner?! This has to be relooked before updating on the website.
- To have a statistical analysis on the assessment pattern of IA & ETE which will shed some light on the robustness of the evaluation which we are following at present.
- Availability of faculties/classrooms & other logistics has to be considered while offering courses under various baskets.





4) The presented framework/schema with detailed programme structure, course plans, assessment pattern must be discussed in detail with experts of central Curriculum Conclave committee and taken to the next Academic Council before implementation.

 date in the degree certificate will be the date of completion of all the academic
 formalities. They need not wait for their degree certificate till the next convocation.
- To bring these details of such degrees to the subsequent Academic Council Meetings for the ratifications.



 If any of these candidates would like to attend the convocation (especially, to receive the degree on the stage), will be permitted in the subsequent convocation.

36AC (B-7-1) TAPMI School of Business

- Approval of introducing two new elective courses in General Management domain: International Business (MOOC based in Coursera) & Corporate Governance (MOOC based in Coursera) in Trimester-6 starting in February-March 2023 (MBA 2021-23 Batch), and the future batches as well.
- Approval to give the students of MBA 2021-23 Batch and the future batches as well,
 the option to choose two General Management electives from a basket of four
 electives in Trimester-6 starting in February-March 2023: Business Leadership,
 Business Analytics, Corporate Governance and International Business, in accordance
 with the CBCS. All these four courses will be MOOC Courses based on Coursera
 platform. (At present there are only two General Management courses, based on
 Coursera MOOCs, in Trimester-6: Business Leadership and Business Analytics, and
 there is no choice; all students were to compulsorily study both these courses
 mandatorily).
- Approval for increasing the number of credits for Business Analytics (MB7641) from 2 credits at present to 3 credits, in Trimester-6 starting in February-March 2023 (MBA 2021-23 Batch). This will ensure that the total number of credits to be completed will be same across all students (2 general management electives x 3 credits each = 6 credits), notwithstanding the combination of electives they choose from the basket of four.

36AC (B-7-2) School of Hospitality and Tourism Management

- Approval for the assessment of CWS through Coursera in two BHM courses (6th and 7th Semesters).

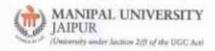
