

With the objective of encouraging meritorious students and academic excellence, the following categories of scholarships are offered to deserving students from first year onwards. The quantum and number of scholarships will be displayed on the website every year.

A. Scholarships for Under- Graduate Students

1. TMA Pai Engineering Scholarships:

Two scholarships in each engineering stream, restricted to students with top 5000 ranks in the MU Engineering Entrance Examination, will be given on merit-cum-means basis as follows:

Parents' combined annual income	Scholarship on annual programme fee
Upto Rs 5 lakhs	100%
Between Rs 5 lakhs and Rs 7.5 lakhs	75%
Between Rs 7.5 lakhs and Rs 10 lakhs	50%
Between Rs 10 lakhs and Rs 12.5 lakhs	25%
Above Rs 12.5 lakhs	10%

Students applying for these scholarships are required to submit copies of their parents' (both mother and father) Form 16/16A/ITR of the last two years. These documents are to be submitted every year.

To continue to get the scholarship, the student should maintain a CGPA of 8.0 or above every academic year, failing which the scholarship for the subsequent years will be withdrawn.

2. Scholarships for Lateral Entry (Diploma) / Transfer Cases:

Scholarships will be offered to meritorious students who take admission under Lateral Entry (Diploma) / Transfer category as per the criteria given below:

- One scholarship in each engineering stream and one in each non-engineering programme, amounting to 25% of the annual programme fees will be given to student with the highest aggregate marks in excess of 60% / CGPA 6.0 or above, without any backlogs.
- To continue to get the scholarship, the student should maintain a CGPA of 6.0 or above, failing which, the scholarship for the subsequent years will be withdrawn.



3. TMA Pai Merit Scholarships:

- a) One Scholarship in each stream of engineering and one in each non-engineering programme, with 100% waiver on annual tuition fees, will be given to the student with the highest aggregate marks in excess of 90%, in the qualifying exam.
- b) One Scholarship in each stream of engineering and one in each non-engineering programme, with 50% waiver on annual tuition fees, will be given to the student with the highest aggregate marks in excess of 80%, in the qualifying exam.
- c) One Scholarship in each stream of engineering and one in each non-engineering programme, with 25% waiver on annual tuition fees, will be given to the student with the highest aggregate marks in excess of 75%, in the qualifying exam to continue to get the scholarships, the students should maintain a CGPA of 8.0 or above, failing which the scholarship for the subsequent years will be withdrawn.

4. Rajasthan Merit Scholarships:

One Scholarship, in each stream of engineering and one in each non-engineering programme of up to Rs 1 Lakh each, will be given to a student of Rajasthan domicile, with the highest aggregate marks in excess of 80% in 10+2 or equivalent qualifying exam. To be eligible, the student should have passed his/her 10th and 10+2 exam from a school in Rajasthan.

- a) The maximum scholarship given to each student will not exceed the annual fees of the programme joined, or Rs. 1 Lakh, whichever is lower.
- b) To continue to get the scholarship, the student should maintain a CGPA of 7.5 or above, failing which the scholarship for the subsequent years will be withdrawn.

5. Scholarships/Seat Reservations for Local Region Students:

For the benefit of students from nearby villages of Dehmi Kalan, Thikaria and Sanjharia and to promote education amongst them, the following are available:

5.1 Reservation of Seats:

Two seats each, with 50% annual programme fee-waiver on the basis of merit, are reserved in the following programmes (other than B. Tech) for the students with highest merit.

To continue to get the scholarships, the students should pass every year **without any backlogs**, failing which the scholarship for the subsequent years will be withdrawn

5.2 Financial Support:

Rs 500/- per month will be given to two students, other than those mentioned in 5.1 above, from each of the above mentioned programmes, who have 75% and above aggregate marks.

To continue to get the scholarships, the students should pass every year **without any backlogs**, failing which the scholarships for the subsequent years will be withdrawn.

B. Scholarships for Post- Graduate Students

1. Tuition Fee Concession for MUJ Graduates:

To promote and support MUJ graduates taking admissions in PG programmes in MUJ itself, a fee concession is offered as per the details given under:

UG score	Amount of Concession on Tuition Fee
CGPA 8.5 and above	20%
CGPA 7 and above	15%
CGPA 5 and above	10%

2. Scholarships & Seat Reservation for Local Region Students in MBA & M Tech Programmes:

For students from nearby villages of Dehmi Kalan, Thikaria and Sanjharia, enrolled in **MBA and M Tech programmes**, two seats are reserved in each programme, and are offered on merit cum means basis. Scholarships amounting to 50% of the annual programme fee will be granted. The scholarships offered will be subject to fulfill the following conditions:

- i. Annual Income of both parents put together should be less than 7.5 Lacs

- ii. To continue to avail the scholarships, the students must maintain CGPA of 7.0 or above, failing which the scholarships for the next year will be withdrawn.

3. TSB Merit cum Means Scholarships – MBA Program:

Ten scholarships are available for meritorious students with the following criteria:

- a) Minimum 60% aggregate marks in all exams (10th, 12th and Graduation)
- b) The students should be among the top 50% of the admitted MBA batch for that academic year, on the basis of his/her graduation marks/grade

The number and extent of scholarships are as follows:

To continue to get the scholarships, the student should maintain a CGPA of 7.5 or above, failing which the scholarships for the next year will be withdrawn.

Students applying for these scholarships are required to submit copies of their parents’ (both mother and father) Form 16/16A/ITR of the last two years. These documents are to be submitted every year.

4. Merit Scholarships for PG students

a) For M Tech students

Five Scholarships in each M Tech Specialization will be given to students with the highest GATE score. The number and extent of Scholarships are as follows:

b) For MSc and LLM students

Three Scholarships in each Programme will be given to students with the highest aggregate marks in the qualifying exam. The number and extent of Scholarships are as follows:

5. Contingency / Teaching Assistantship for Ph D Scholars

All registered part time external Ph D Research scholars are eligible for financial support upto Rs 5000/- per scholar to attend one National / International Conference / Technical festival during their PhD course duration (3 Years).

Teaching assistantship of Rs 15,000/- per month will be available to full time Ph.D. scholars, for three years, along with a Contingency amount of Rs 12,000/- p.a.

A few selected M. Tech Final year students will be awarded Teaching Assistantship of Rs 5000/- per month, based on the recommendation of the Department.

C. Financial Support for both UG & PG students

Financial Support for attending Seminars/Conferences

Financial aid will be given to Pre-final and final year students to present R&D work/papers at Seminars/Conferences of repute, as per the conditions mentioned below:

D Admission under Sports Quota (from 2016-17 session)**Number of Seats**

Up to 1% of total seats in Engineering and 2% in Non- Engineering Programmes will be allowed under sports quota (on qualifying the entrance test). Competent Authority will decide on allowing additional seats in exceptional circumstances. Unfilled seats of sports' quota till the pre announced date of admission, will be filled by general category students.

Eligibility

The candidate should either be a State Champion or should have participated in recognized National level / Inter-University level (AIU) / International Level sports Competitions.

The candidate should have cleared the qualifying exam for admission to the Programme applied for, with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate. A relaxation of 5% marks can be given by the Competent Authority.

Fee Waiver

- a) 30% fee waiver in tuition fee will be allowed, if the candidate is either State Champion or has participated at recognized National / All India Inter-University (AIU) level sports competitions.
- b) 60% fee waiver in tuition fee will be allowed, if the candidate has won Silver / Bronze Medal at recognized National / All India Inter-University (AIU) level sports competitions.
- c) 80% fee waiver in tuition fee will be allowed, if the candidate has won Gold Medal at recognized National / All India Inter-University (AIU) level sports competitions.
- d) 100% fee waiver of tuition fee will be allowed, if the candidate has represented the country at recognized International level sports competitions.

NOTE:

- a) *Only those games / sports will be considered for the above mentioned incentives / schemes, which are in the list of International Olympic Committee (IOC), Indian Olympic Association (IOA), Association of Indian Universities (AIU), School Nationals, MYAS (Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports) and others.*
- b) *To continue to get the fee waiver, the student should maintain a CGPA of 5.0 or above, failing which the fee-waiver for the subsequent years shall be withdrawn.*

- c) *The student would be required to participate actively at University level Sports activities.*
- d) *The student's participation in various events, would be subject to the prior permission / approval.*

E. ENDOWMENT FUND

- a) Enhancement of research scholarships at par with reputed Institutions: In order to attract the best research scholars to MUJ and strengthen its research output, the PhD Fellowship for full-time external research scholars will be enhanced to be at par with the IITs and Central Universities.
- b) Introduction of scholarships for MTech students: Currently MUJ is unable to attract quality MTech students, because GATE scholarships are not available. It is proposed to give scholarships at par with IITs to all MTech students who are GATE qualified.
- c) Scholarships for international students: to increase diversity of student intake, it is proposed attract more international/NRI students by providing scholarships to them.

Please note the following in context of all the above scholarships:

- a) The above scholarships are applicable only to students taking admission from the academic session 2016-17 onwards
- b) A student cannot hold more than one scholarship concurrently from any source or supporting agency.
- c) Scholarships will be given only for the actual/minimum duration of the programme in which the student is enrolled.



- d) Grant of scholarships will cease in case any indiscipline case/matter is reported against the student.
- e) In case of any dispute, the decision of the President MUJ would be final and binding.
- f) To continue to get the scholarship, the student should maintain the result without any backlogs, failing which the scholarships for the subsequent years will be withdrawn
