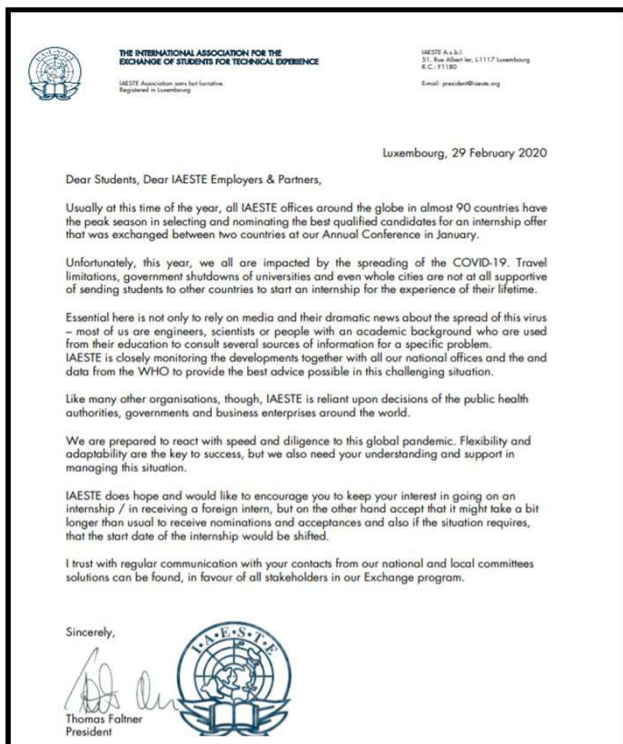

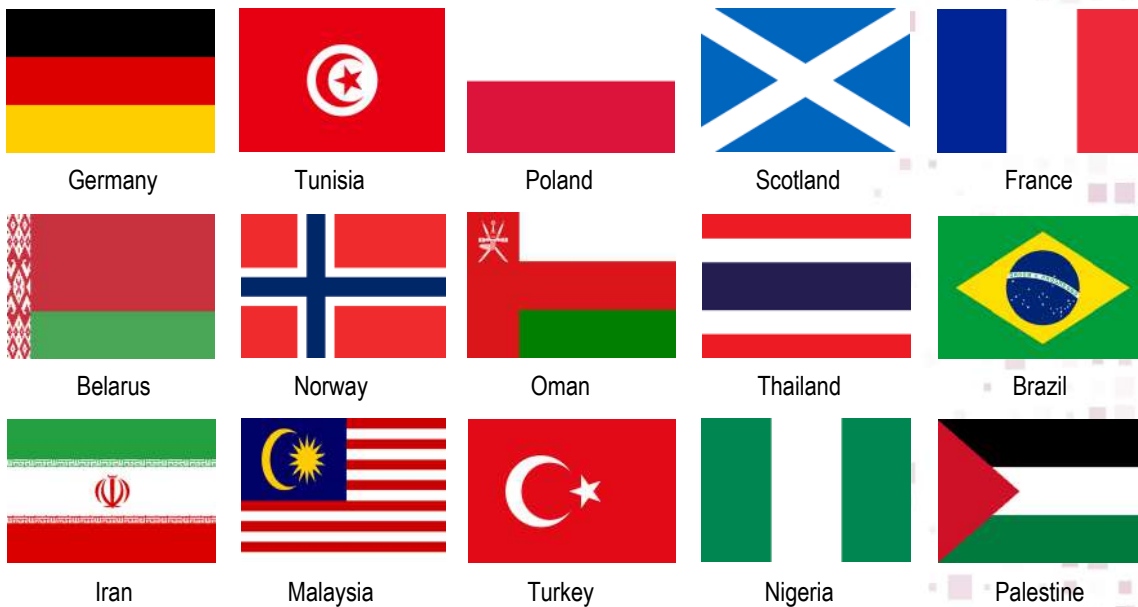
Student Engagement

Student Exchange Programs

The Directorate assists interested students for Semester Exchange Programs by coordinating with their respective Departments to confirm credit exchange possibilities & parity (Credit Mapping) in terms of courses on offer during particular semester at a partner University or Institution. Information received from partner Institution regarding opportunities for internship & semester exchange are constantly shared with students & faculty through email/poster on notice board.

Information regarding new MoU's, academic and research opportunities available (apart from existing MoU's) are shared as and when received from various agencies like NTU India Connect, Rhodes scholarship, Linnaeus Palme (Sweden) etc. with students and faculty of concerned departments.

The Directorate apart from sharing information also assists students and faculty with required certificates or reference letter for visit and VISA, on receiving confirmation from partner Institutions.


