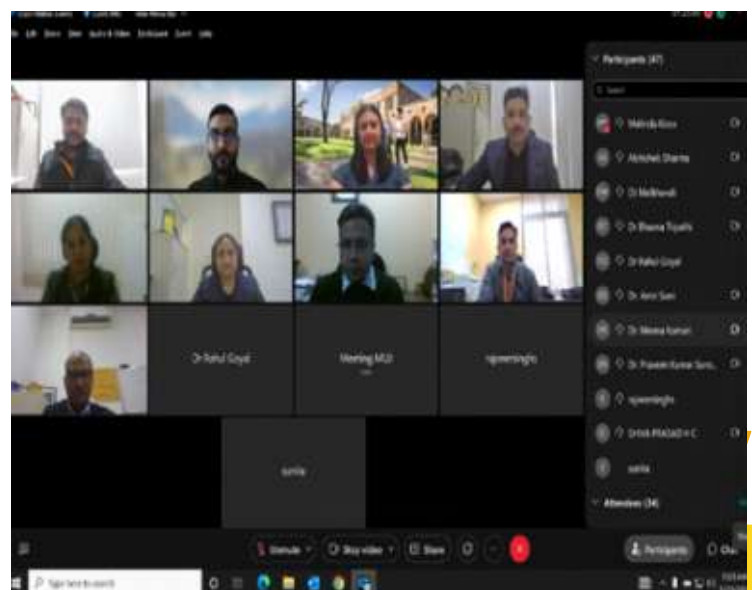
Manipal Virtual Summer School 2021 (MVSS 2021) (15 July 2021-30 July 2021)

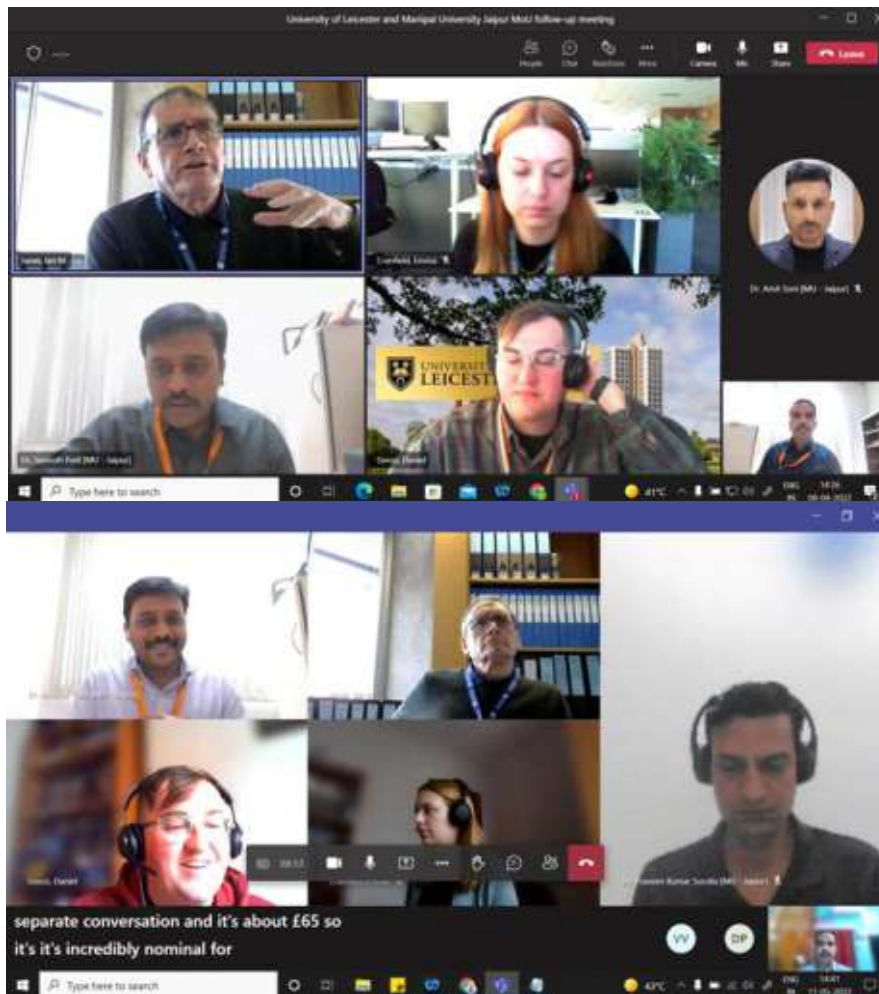
