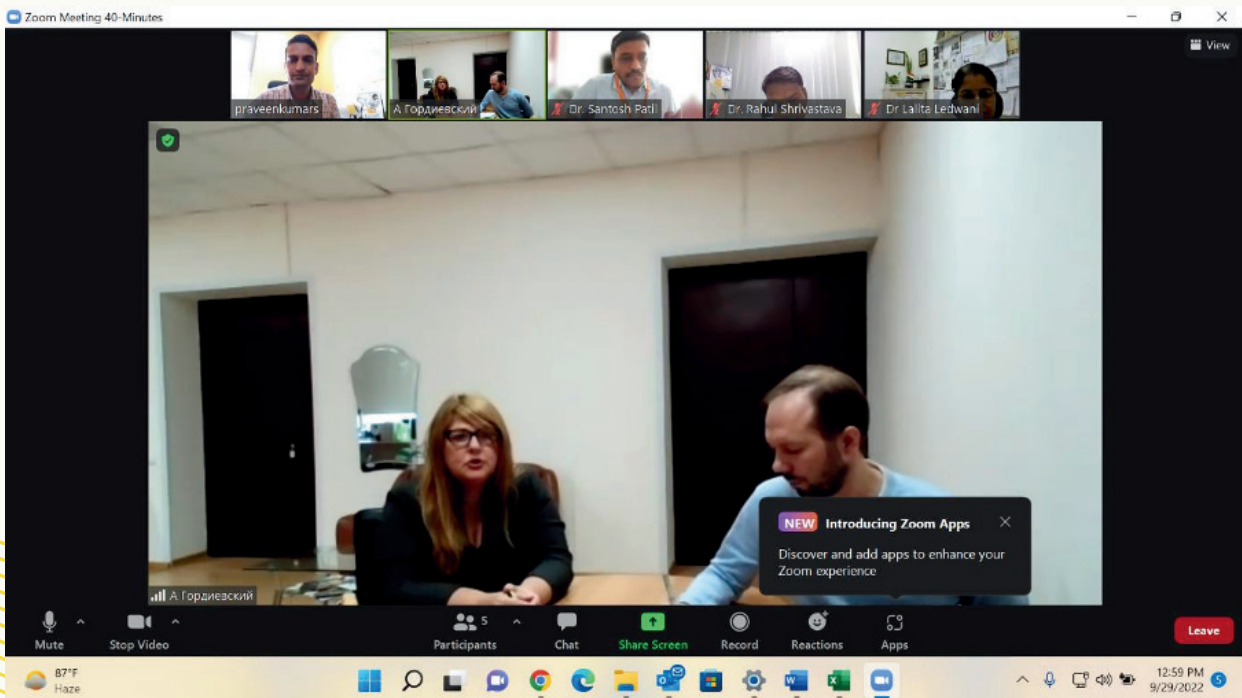

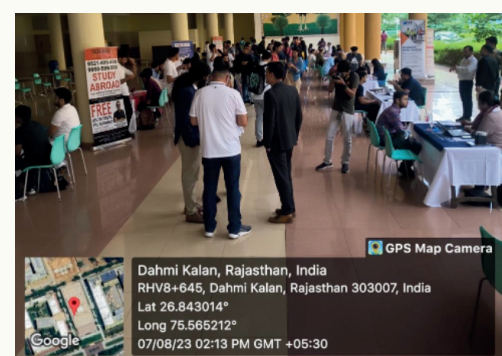
Seminar on 'Overseas Education - A Plethora of Opportunities' by Global reach on April 12TH 2023.

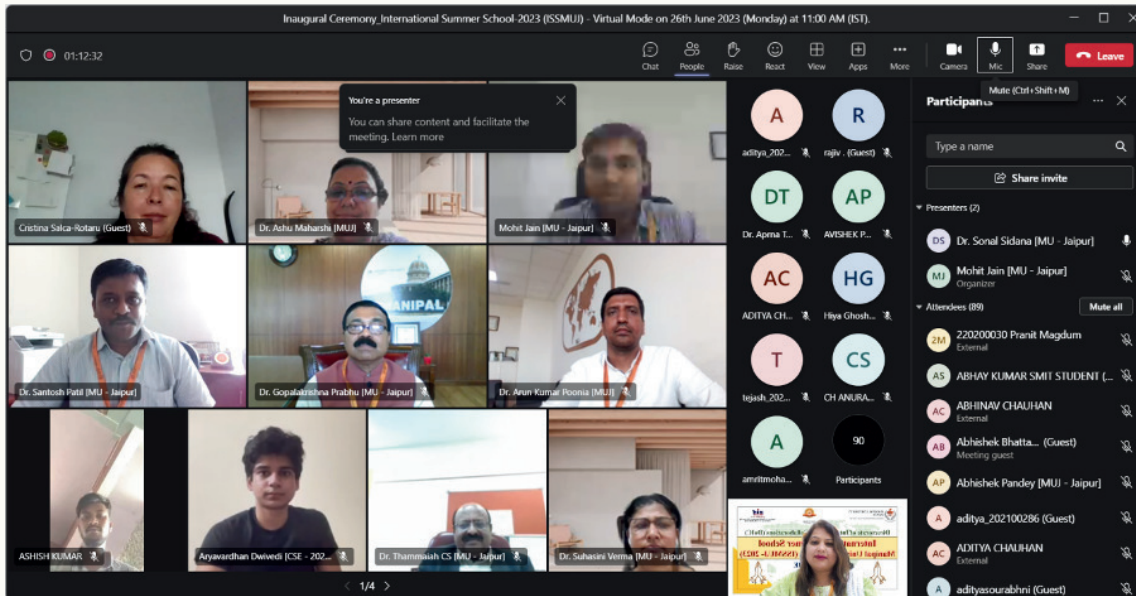

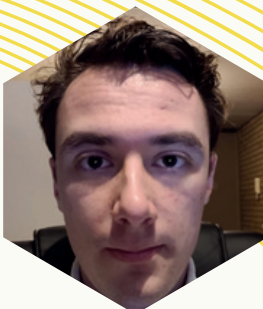

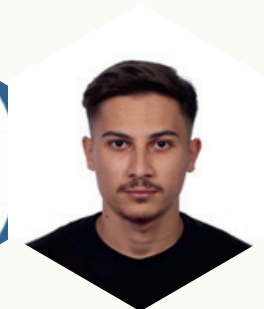
